Application for the Living Water Tuition Scholarship

The Charlevoix Foundation through its Living Water Tuition Scholarship supports eligible students of Community Christian College in their pursuit of an Associate of Arts (AA) degree.

Instructions

Students at Community Christian College who would like to be considered for the Living Water Tuition Scholarship must complete the attached application. Award decisions will be made by the Charlevoix Foundation at the start of each quarter for new students who meet the Student Eligibility requirements.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible to receive the Living Water Tuition Scholarship applicants must:

- Have a high school diploma, GED certificate, or pass an Ability to Benefit test
- Enroll and continue to enroll full time (minimum of 12 quarter hours per quarter) at Community Christian College
- Complete the current FAFSA application for each year of enrollment or be a recipient of a World Student Scholarship through CCC.
- Complete the Charlevoix Foundation Living Water Tuition Scholarship application prior to attending courses at Community Christian College
- Maintain a satisfactory GPA of 2.5 (including any developmental courses) while enrolled at Community Christian College

A limited number of scholarships are available per quarter and campus. All scholarships will be granted on a first-come, first-served basis. The Living Water Tuition Scholarship will be applied toward tuition and fees only. Each scholarship has a maximum award amount of \$2,000.00 and will be distributed in equal amounts over three quarters. All new full time students who meet the Student Eligibility Requirements are encouraged to apply.
